Excellence Awards are monetary awards given to graduating seniors to help them jump start their careers. These awards can be used to continue their education **OR** to purchase any tools, equipment, certifications, etc. that will help them accomplish their career goals.

Innovative Instructional Programs

Through EITC donations, the Bridges Foundation provides unique educational opportunities for the students of BAVTS. We offer a dual enrollment Entrepreneurship class and a Professional Skills Certification through Northampton Community College. Both of these classes provide students with knowledge they can use in any field they choose.

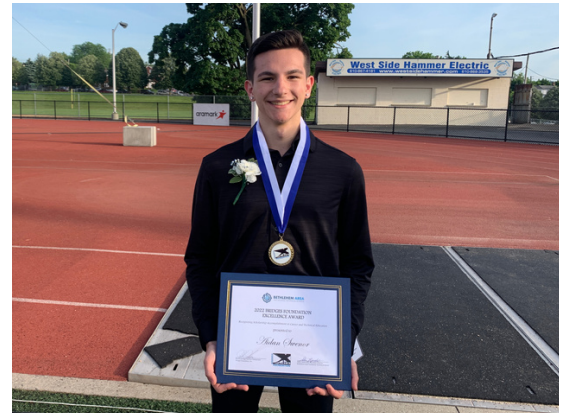
Supporting BAVTS

EXCELLENCE AWARDS

Since 1999, the Bridges Foundation has awarded \$958,250 in awards to BAVTS students.



Whether students are continuing their education or entering the workforce, our Awards help BAVTS students jumpstart their future.



In 2023, we awarded \$57,500 to 26 seniors from 17 different BAVTS Programs.



INNOVATIVE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

Dual Enrollment Courses

BAVTS students have the opportunity to take an Entrepreneurship Course through Northampton Community College and receive college credit at no cost to them. In the course, they learn how to develop an entrepreneurial mindset which can benefit them regardless of their program of study. Students in the Academy of Applied Engineering also have the opportunity to receive college credit through Lafayette College for their Introduction to Engineering course.

Professional Skills Certification

According to the Lehigh Valley Economic Development Corporation's Business and Industry Survey, one of the top needs in the workforce is employability and soft skills. The Foundation has worked with BAVTS and NCC to create a Professional Skills certification program. In this class, students learn the soft/employability skills that businesses are looking for. Upon completion of the course, students receive an official certification which guarantees they will be high-quality employees, regardless of the position.





SUPPORTING BAVTS

At the Bridges Foundation, we take any opportunity we can to invest in BAVTS and its students, to create an outstanding workforce for the future. One of our biggest investments was the purchase of the BAVTS Food Truck. Last year the food truck appeared at 20+ events in the community. The Food Truck promotes BAVTS while providing students with real life experience. We will continue to look for new ways to support BAVTS.
